

Don Miguel Lanz

Characteristics

Miguel is not only the aging head of the family, but also a man who turned nothing into a fortune; sometimes, he tends to operate his family as if it was his business enterprise. He is very strong-minded, stubborn and he doesn't appreciate being resisted. Ever since his wife died, he feels something has been missing in his life.

The Past

- Originally, Miguel had two sons - twins. However, he could not afford to support both children, so he put one in an orphanage and decided to raise only the other one (Roberto).
- Camiliáno Pereira (Helena's husband) and Radquez Hernández were his business partners. Together with Radquez, they devised a plan to become unbelievably rich. In this plan, Camiliáno was unknowingly playing the role of a scapegoat and he ended up spending a better part of his life in prison. It was through a major fraud Miguel and Radquez made their fortune. They are trying to keep everything secret.
- Miguel is more fond of his dead wife Sofia than his weak son Rather than his weak son Roberto.
- When Miguel became older, he wanted to atone for his many sins. It was then that he started employing members of the Pereira family in his business. Natália Pereira proved to be a very good accountant.
- Sofia Lanz had a baby out of wedlock, by Juan Pereira. Don Miguel wanted the baby to cause Sofia and Roberto's marriage to fall apart. It would destroy Roberto, and Sofia would certainly remain a divorcee with no resources. But he was too fond of Sofia to let this happen. That is why Don Miguel put this illegitimate child into an orphanage. They told Roberto the child died shortly after birth.
- Don Miguel believes that Juan Pereira took the baby out of the orphanage and raised him as his own. Ramirez Pereira is this child!
- Fifteen years ago, Sofia Lanz was in a serious car accident. Natalia Pereira was in the car with her and Miguel thinks the accident occurred because the two had started fighting because of Juan and the baby. Sofia died in the crash; Natalia has been comatose ever since.

Relationships

- Miguel preferred Sofia, his daughter-in-law, to his son Roberto. In his opinion, Roberto is a weakling. Miguel cannot imagine Roberto running the family business one day.
- And Olympia? She is a mere gold-digger, that's what she is! Miguel hates her.
- However, he loves his grandchildren, especially Rosalinda - he tends to spoil her a bit. There's nothing he wouldn't do for her.

- He hates the entire Pereira family and he despises Juan who seduced poor Sofia the most. It is Juan who is to blame for her death, because it was him Sofia and Natalia were fighting about.
- Miguel feels guilty about Helena Pereira because of the fraud they committed and used her husband as a scapegoat.
- Lorenzo is a nice guy; one day, he's going to be a good chamberlain.
- Hernán Hernández is the future head of the big enterprise. His marriage to Rosalinda is vital for the well-being of the Lanz family. Someone has to keep an eye on these young silly fools.

Roberto Lanz

Characteristics

If someone was trying to describe Roberto, they would say Roberto is kind. Very kind. Roberto is nice, warm and has some understanding for everyone. His behavior is naive and he is very susceptible to influence, something everybody knows about him.

The Past

- If luck had been on Roberto's side, he would have had one child more in his life today. Today, the baby would be perhaps a year older than Rosalinda. However, the baby boy died shortly after birth.
- Sofia was killed in a tragic car accident fifteen years ago, and ever since then, Roberto has been taking anti-depressants.
- She was driving with her friend, Natália Pereira. Since the accident, Natália has been in a coma.
- Roberto keeps fighting with his father constantly because of Olympia; Roberto adores her and so he spoils her with expensive presents. He is unable to say no to her. A week ago, he bought her a beautiful car, brand new! It makes Roberto happy when Olympia is happy.
- However, Roberto has been feeling watched or followed recently. He has nightmares. Sometimes even anxiety attacks!

Relationships

- Roberto loves his wife Olympia.
- He cares even more about his children, Rosalinda and Carlos. Even though he may have spoiled them a bit, he loves them very much. They grew up without a mother, only with Olympia, which couldn't have been easy. Roberto is upset that his children do not get along well with Olympia.
- His father, Don Miguel, is strict but just. Roberto respects him.
- Adriana Salazar is Olympia's best friend. She hangs around the Lanz residence a lot. She is rich and fairly fun.
- Hernán Hernández is a rich young guy. Roberto is not too fond of him. He would like Rosalinda to marry someone for love. This marriage is a child of reason, not love. Hernán's father, Radquez Hernández, is a long-term business partner of Miguel's and Miguel has already decided about the marriage.
- Lorenzo Lorenz is a young guy who took up the chamberlain position at Lanz residence. The former chamberlain quit his job and fled the city in a suspicious hurry. Lorenzo showed up just in time and with great recommendations, so Roberto hired him.

Jorge Lanz

Characteristics

In this moment, Roberto leaves and it is up to you to play the role of the evil twin, Jorge Lanz. Jorge is the very opposite of Roberto. He is a sinister genius of evil who wants to get the family in as much trouble and conflict as possible. Jorge hates the family, especially his brother Roberto who has always had everything served on a silver platter, unlike Jorge. But Jorge is smart and ambitious, power-hungry, assertive, decisive and super-evil. Therefore, you have to completely reverse Roberto's personality.

The Past

- Jorge is Roberto's twin his father decided to put in an orphanage. He grew up in that orphanage and he swore vengeance on both Lanz family and Pereira family.
- Jorge studied the art of vengeance with a Japanese master. Vengeance became the meaning of his life.
- Twenty years ago, he founded a branch under Roberto's name within the Lanz corporation. It is a secret facility making drugs Jorge uses to destroy lives of thousands of people.
- However, Natália Pereira, the accountant Miguel hired, discovered the whole drug deal. Jorge staged a car crash in which Roberto's wife Sofia died and Natália Pereira fell into coma.
- Jorge has been coming to the Lanz residence for a long time; he became familiar with all the inhabitants. However, he despises every single one of them and wants them to suffer.
- He knows Lorenzo Lorenz is a woman dressed as a man. He uses this particular piece of information only when he needs to bring Lorenzo in line. It is always handy to have some dirt you can blackmail people with.
- Not so long ago, Jorge pushed Don Miguel down the stairs. Unfortunately, the old man survived.
- Jorge managed to defeat Roberto and hid him, shot, in a place known only to himself. Now, Jorge poses as Roberto.

Relationships

- Jorge hates everybody.

Olympia Lanz

Characteristics

The second wife of Roberto Lanz and stepmother to Rosalinda and Carlos. She married her older husband only because of his money and she has him completely wrapped around her finger. She secretly hates her stepchildren. She hides her evil self behind pretense and she does it all because of money. She hopes that when Miguel dies, she will gain control over the entire family and their entire property.

The Past

- She has plenty of lovers, but she has been seeing Hernán, Rosalinda's boyfriend, for some time now.
- Olympia has just become pregnant, but she doesn't know it yet.
- She has been splashing her husband's money about and she lets him buy her expensive presents. A week ago, she bought a cool expensive car.

Relationships

- She hates Don Miguel.
- She treats her husband Roberto like a puppet. He is a wimp and he is not able to say no to her.
- Olympia is only playing with Hernán for fun. There is no great love story behind their encounters.
- However, Olympia finds the new chamberlain Lorenzo Lorenz very attractive. If an opportunity arises, she would like to take him somewhere aside and make a few dirty proposals.
- Rosalinda and Carlos, Roberto's children from his first marriage, are a necessary evil that came along with all the money.
- Adriana Salazar is Olympia's best friend. They understand each other very well.

Rosalinda Lanz

Characteristics

Rosalinda is young, beautiful and rich. She values people who are rich and stylish. We wouldn't say that she is plain stupid. Only her pride and self-confidence are so big that she never admits there is something she doesn't know or that she might do wrongly. She compensates this by the amount of talking she does. However, that is only the mask she wears in public; her real self is very kind and nice, just like her father's. She believes in love at the first sight.

The Past

- Rosalinda's mother Sofia died in a car crash fifteen years ago. She was driving together with Natália Pereira who has been in a coma ever since.
- Hernán proposed to her and she agreed to marry him. Grandfather would have wished so. Moreover, Hernán has always been nothing but very nice and attentive. Relationships

- Carlos hangs out with José Armando Medina a lot. They are best friends.
- Valentina may be ugly as sin, but she is the kindest person. Carlos likes her.
- He would have probably been friends with Ramirez Pereira, if Ramirez wasn't seeing Adriana whom Carlos is pining for.
- Carlos finds Adriana very attractive. She is not that much older than him. He might have a shot with her.
- Carlos has good and warm relationship with his father and sister.
- He openly hates her stepmother Olympia. After all, she's not too keen on him either.
- Grandfather Miguel may be strict sometimes, but he is always just. Miguel hates the Pereiras, but Carlos doesn't mind any of that. He has his own judgment.

- Daughter of Juan Pereira and Sofia Lanz.
- She works as a chamberlain at the Lanz family; she made the former chamberlain quit his job and leave the town using threats and blackmail. She acquired a fake letter of recommendation and convinced Roberto to hire her.
- She put up a fake ad on a dating site. She hopes Valentina Pereira will swallow the bait and leave the house.
- Sofia looks very much alike her sister Valentina. Only Sofia is more beautiful. When she doesn't pretend to be a man, that is.

Relationships

- Roberto Lanz was the one who hired her. He is a wimp who only manipulates everyone.
- Don Miguel is one not to be toyed with. Lorenzo walks on eggshells around him. She will try to learn more about how Miguel was involved in her placement in the orphanage.
- She also has to discover what happened to her mother Sofia Lanz.
- Olympia is clearly the future head of the family; she is evil and hostile and she has her eye on Lorenzo. Maybe, this could be used to Sofia's advantage.
- Carlos is a wimp, just like his father.
- Juan Pereira - Lorenzo's father - will feel the worst of Sofia's vengeance.
- For reasons unfathomable to Sofia, Lorenzo is a chick magnet. Of course Lorenzo strictly refuses all of them!

- He has a son Juan, who was married to Natália Pereira (née Medina).
- Helena knows about her son Juan's affair with Roberto Lanz's ex-wife Sofia Lanz. A child was born out of this relationship. And Helena Pereira is positive this child is Rosalinda Lanz!
- Natália worked for Don Miguel as an accountant.
- Fifteen years ago, Natália and Sofia Lanz were driving together and had a car accident. Sofia died in the crash and Natália suffered a severe head injury. Ever since then, Natália has been in a coma. Sofia Lanz, who was driving, caused the crash.

Relationships

- She hates the Lanz family. They are to blame for her Camiliáno going to prison, her family becoming poor as well as for the car crash. Her grandchildren lost their mother because of the Lanz family. Helena never misses an opportunity to say something mean about the Lanzas and to spread rumors about them. - Juan is married to Natália and the couple has two children, Valentina and Ramirez.
- Natália worked for Don Miguel as an accountant.
- Juan used to be quite a womanizer. Shortly after his wedding, Juan had a passionate affair with Sofia Lanz, the deceased wife of Roberto Lanz. Juan knows his wife had a baby with Juan. But he doesn't know, what happened with the baby. When Sofia got pregnant, she stopped seeing him. Judging by the age, Rosalinda Lanz could be Juan's daughter.
- Juan's mother Helena knows about the affair.
- Fifteen years ago, Natália and Sofia Lanz were driving together and had a car accident. Sofia died in the crash and Natália suffered a severe head injury. Ever since then, Natália has been in a coma.
- Maria Medina, Natália's sister, helped Juan out a lot after the accident. She stays with the Pereira family, along with her son José Armando.

Relationships

- But Valentina is good friends with Carlos Lanz. Grandma Helena mustn't know about this, because for some reason, she hates the guts of every Lanz family member. Valentina is in love with Carlos, but he doesn't know it. He would never date anyone like Valentina.
- She knows José Armando and Carlos are best friends. But no one in the family talks about it, because grandma Helen would get upset and angry.

Relationships

- Valentina is in love with Carlos Lanz.
- She is very fond of her brother Ramirez and their cousin José Armando; they all grew up together.

- Natália Pereira, Ramirez's mother, was in a tragic car accident fifteen years ago and she has been in a coma since then. Ramirez's aunt Maria Medina, Natália's sister, has been taking care of Ramirez, his sister Valentina and their cousin José Armando ever since.
- Valentina is good friends with Carlos Lanz. Carlos Lanz is José Armando's best friend.
- His father Juan and grandma Helena hate the Lanz family.

Characteristics

- He is also very good friends with Valentina Pereira and Ramirez Pereira.
- José Armando doesn't know or need his father. He decided that he would cope without him in the world. Earlier, he hated his father for leaving his mother. But now, he couldn't care less.

Relationships

- José Armando's best friend is Carlos Lanz. They are more than brothers to each other.
- José Armando hates when Maria takes pills. It is clear enough to him that she is addicted to them.
- Valentina and Ramirez are like sister and brother to him. They grew up together.
- He views Juan as a father he has never met. He respect Juan.
- He has only seen Adriana a couple of times, always with Ramirez. He is not sure whether she remembers him or not. However, José finds her very beautiful and desirable.
- Helena is an unpleasant bitter old woman.

Hernán Hernández

Characteristics

- But Hernán does not love Rosalinda. His relationship to her is purely pragmatic.
- Hernán has been seeing Olympia Lanz, Rosalinda's stepmother, for some time now.
- Hernán's father gives him money for basic stuff, but if Hernán wants to afford something without his father's approval, he has to sell illegally acquired medicinal drugs.
- One of his customers is Maria Medina.

Relationships

- Radquez Hernández is Hernán's father. He is a terrible tyrant.
- Rosalinda Lanz is Hernán's future fiancé. She is a good friend to him, but there are no deeper feelings involved.
- Neither does Hernán love Olympia he's sleeping with. He only maintains this relationship out of boredom and lack of excitement.
- Maria Medina is one of his customers. He regularly supplies her with pills she's addicted to.
- Unfathomably, Hernán finds himself attracted to Lorenzo Lorenz. However, he doesn't admit to himself he could be gay. His father would get a heart attack out of something like that. Despite that, it is hard to resist this certain electric tension he feels, so he hangs out with Lorenzo and treats him as a good friend and confidante.
